On the first day of the workshop, Google and Kahoot were presented.

In the afternoon, participants created Kahoot accounts and got information about Kahoot. They learned how to create a simple classroom contest and pin code procedures. Then, all the participants created simple contests and invited students to Kahoot . At the end of the session, they shared the contest results.

In the evening, all participants and the teachers of Bakırköy Cumhuriyet Ortaokulu were invited a dinner by municipality of Bakırköv, İstanbul. The first day of the mobility finished with the first official meeting was held at the hotel's meeting room. During the meeting the coordinator reminded some basic rules of the project and asked for opinions of partners. The Polish team made a presentation about the location of first cultural camp of the project and shared some information about the accommodation.

#### 20th of March, 2018

The second day of the workshop was started with the presentation about Edmodo by Ms. Nermin TARI. Participants created their Edmodo account. They formed classes and connected to the students. They learned how to share documents, links, quizzes and polls.





In the afternoon, participants learned how to set up Scratch and received general information about it. Then, they started to In the morning session, participants created their Google create simple animations and made sprites to talk and move. All of the participants enjoyed creating interactive animation and games.
